Description

- Allows Conditionally Ready seniors to satisfy the CSU Entry Level Math requirement using an online math tutorial
- Provides structure and guidance from CSU math faculty
- Requires 15-50 hours of self-paced instruction culminating in a proctored final assessment
- Costs \$45 (fee waivers available for those with financial hardship)

Eligibility Requirements

- In order to participate high school seniors must have either:
 - Received an "EAP Conditionally Ready" score and/or "Standard Met" score on the CAASPP test –**or**–
 - Scored between 520-560 on the new SAT Math test, or 490-540 on the old SAT Math test, or between 20-22 on the ACT Math test

Benefits

- Provides an opportunity for Conditionally Ready students to:
 - Enroll in for-credit math courses at the CSU
 - Avoid having to take costly preparatory courses at the CSU
- Allows students to avoid having to take the Entry Level Math Exam
